On February 3, 1913, the Sixteenth Amendment of the Constitution was ratified. This amendment states, "The Congress shall have the power to lay and collect taxes on incomes, from whatever source derived, without apportionment among the several States, and without regard to census or enumeration." It is the duty of every citizen to pay income taxes and file a 1040 form.
