Thank you for your recent correspondence

I have reviewed your correspondence regarding your feelings on our country's tax laws. Unfortunately, we cannot always agree on every issue and on this issue we must simply agree to disagree. Nevertheless, I firmly believe you have the right to protest and believe the way you do. In an effort to help you understand my position, I have included government documents with this correspondence that outline the federal government's position on the issues you have consistently argued. I hope these documents answer all your questions.

As a member of Congress, I am challenged with making sure our tax code is administered equitably. I firmly believe these laws have been administered appropriately in your situation. Furthermore, it is my conviction, when you made the decision not to file an income tax return, you blatantly violated the law; therefore, I consider your case to now by a legal matter and for this reason, my office will be unable to assist you in this matter.

Considering the above, I urge you to continue to work with your attorney, since a representative in the legal profession is in the best position to advise, counsel, and to protect you against any violation of your rights. I regret that I cannot provide a more favorable reply and will be unable to provide any further assistance in your case. I consider this issue resolved and closed.
