## Treasury Department Order No. 150-106

Relocation of the Nevada Internal Revenue Service District from Reno to Las Vegas

## Dated: February 8, 1985

Under the authority vested in the President to establish Internal Revenue Districts by Section 7621 of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, and as delegated to the Secretary of the Treasury by Executive Order 10289, 31 U.S.C. §321, Reorganization Plan No. 1 of 1952 as made applicable to the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 by Section 7804(a), and Executive Order 10574, and delegated to me by Treasury Department Order No. 101-5, it is

ordered that:

the headquarters office of the Internal Revenue District for the State of Nevada be transferred from Reno, Nevada, to Las Vegas, Nevada; and the Internal Revenue District for the State of Nevada be known as the Las Vegas Internal Revenue District.

- 1. Las Vegas District: Shall include the State of Nevada, with the headquarters office located in Las Vegas, Nevada.
- 2. District Director of Internal Revenue: The title of the District office shall bear the title "District Director of Internal Revenue," identified by the name of the city or subdivision thereof, in which the headquarters office is located.
- 3. Implementation: The provisions of paragraphs numbered 1-2 of this order shall be implemented upon such date as the Commissioner of Internal Revenue may determine. Effective immediately, the Commissioner of Internal Revenue is authorized to effect, at appropriate times and in an orderly manner, such transfers of functions, personnel, positions, equipment, and funds as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this Order.
- 4. Effect on Prior Department of the Treasury Orders: Paragraph 4(d) of Treasury Order 150-20, dated November 21, 1952 is superseded.
